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## ? Child Care Fees

- Department of Defense determines income categories and fee ranges annually. All fees include meals, snacks, baby food/formula.
- Base selects appropriate fees w/in each (9) income categories for full time (FT) care.
- Full Time: based on Total Family Income (TFI)\*  
\*If fees pose financial hardship, parent can request waiver to 31 MSG/CC for reduced fees.
- Before and After School Care: TFI determines category/rate for specific program.
- Part Day Enrichment: TFI determines category/rate for specific program MWF/TThurs
- Hourly: \$3 per hour per child
- Respite: \$3 per hour per child
- PCSing Care: Paid by Air Force Aid Society. A referral or certificate required.
- Child Care for Volunteers: Paid by Air Force Aid Society, reservation required.
- Summer Camps/School Holiday Camps: Based on TFI
- Give Parents A Break: Paid by Air Force Aid Society/referral certificate required.
- Parents Night Out, Kids Night Out: Flat rate, established in advance/reservation required
- No refunds for federal holidays/child sick days/vacation days
- Parents in full day/B&A programs can sub-lease slots during vacation/time child is out of program.
- CDC pro-rates parent fees when full time slot is used for hourly care.
- All other fees (except hourly care) are computed by using full time care hourly rate in group care >10hrs per day.
- Exception: When duty day exceeds 10hr/day, 1st Sgt/Comdr may request waiver to 10-hour policy from 31 MSG/CC  
\*With approved waiver/during exercises/inspections, add'l charges apply after 50/hrs @ pro-rated hourly rate with verification of extended duty by 1st Sgt or Comander.
- Late pick-up fees (after established closing time): \$1/minute after 5 min grace period.

*All programs are Air Force certified; SA program is accredited by NAA; CDCs by NAEYC.*

## ? Hours of Operation

- CDCs are open Monday thru Friday, 0630-1800.
- School Age Programs are open Monday - Friday, 0630-0745 and 1430-1800 on school days.
- School Age Programs are open Monday - Friday, 0630-1800 Monday - Friday on teacher work days/school vacations; Co-Op Care Program Monday - Friday, 0900-1200.
- Centers extend hours for exercises/inspection/real world events as directed by 31 FW/CC.
- Open for special events
- Closed on federal holidays
- Open by reservation only on family days/goal days/down days.

## ? Child Care Options

- Full Time (M-F/ 10 hours per day, 50 hours per wk)
- Hourly (M-F, space available, reservations required)
- Part Day Enrichment (T/Thurs & MWF)
- Before & After School Care (M-F)
- Respite (M-F, space available)
- Summer Camps/School Holiday Camps (M-F)
- Give Parents A Break (offered monthly Friday nights or Saturdays, reservations required).
- Parents Night Out, Kids Night Out, offered monthly Friday nights, reservations required.
- PCSing Care (reservations required).
- Co-Op Care volunteer and receive free child care in return.

## ? Waiting List for Full Day Care

- Register for immediate or future care by completing DD Form 2606, Request for Care and by supplying orders or proof of Command Sponsorship.
- Activate when care is projected.
- Priority for care: working parents.
- CDC validates waiting list bi-monthly.
- When slot is offered, parent must accept/decline within 24 hours, pay deposit w/in 48 hours and complete Air Force Form 1181, AF Youth Flight Program Patron. If slot is declined, DD Form 2606, Request for Care, becomes null and void. Parent can come into center and change form completion date to reactivate requirement.



## ? Waiting List for Hourly Care

- PCS reservations may be made 45 days in advance.
- Priority on hourly or waiting list is PCSing families 7 days in/out.
- All other requests, 30 days in advanced.
- **IMPORTANT:** Leave name/number if hourly care request cannot be confirmed when requested; CDC staff will contact as soon as slot can be confirmed.
