STAP application submission is strictly online. The dates for the Fall II STAP applications are 16 September to 22 October 2011. The deadline for applications is 22 October 2011.

If you have not done so, log on to <https://aiportal.acc.af.mil/stap/> and create your account and complete your application.

What is STAP? Spousal Tuition Assistance Program is designed to provide partial tuition assistance for spouses of active duty airmen or officers, who accompany members to

overseas locations and will be attending college programs at those overseas locations. The focus of the program is on the completion of degree or certificate programs that provide increased occupational opportunities for spouses. Spouses are eligible for up to \$300 per term, equivalent to \$1500 per school year.

Aviano Education Center has certified test proctors to administer civilian university exams, PME exams (Course 14, SOS, ACSC, and AWC), DAN TES exams (Speech DSST, PRAXIS, ACT, SAT and GED), and the Defense Language Aptitude Battery (DLAB).

Exam times are Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday with 2 testing times: 8:30am and 10:30am.

The Defense Language Proficiency Test (DLPT) is also administered on space available bases.

The SAT will be offered in October. The PRAXIS will be offered in November.

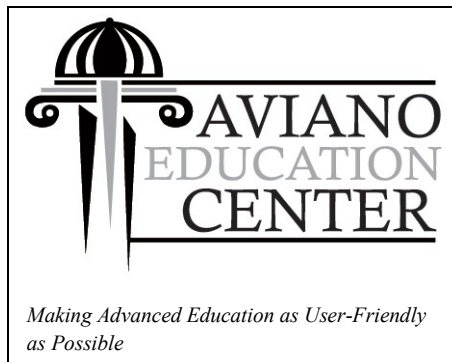
