Golf Course House Rules:

No outside food or drink is allowed to be brought in and/or consumed while on the Alpine Golf Course premises. Private coolers are not allowed. All Players must have their own set of clubs when playing the course, no sharing. Groups of five or more are not allowed except during special family programs or when course use is low (Note: Groups of five players must have advanced approval by the pro shop). Repair ball marks and replace divots at all times. Additional course rules are both listed on the scorecard and next to the first tee box.

Dress Code:

Collared shirts are required for all players. Proper foot wear includes soft spiked golf shoes, tennis shoes, or flat soled shoes with low heels. The following items are not allowed when playing the golf course: T-shirts, running or gym type shorts, cut-offs, sweat pants, halter or tank tops, sleeveless shirts (mens), midriiffs or any part of the military uniform.
