

TSGT FELICIA BENAVIDES, DFAC

TSgt Felicia Benavides exceeds expectations daily and leads a team of 31 members, overseeing 2 dining facilities. She organized the quarterly Mongolian meal - a customer favorite at the LDV DFAC - which led to a 25% increase in customer usage of the facility. TSgt Benavides also led the installation of two new cash registers, training 13 staff members on the new capabilities. These registers enhanced the operation for Aviano patrons by adding credit card/tap to pay options to the facility, and also reduced the wait time for customers by 50%. TSgt Benavides also went TDY in support of current tensions between Ukraine/Russia, where she set up feeding and lodging contracts for joint forces in the area.

CIVILIAN PERSONNEL FLIGHT

Faced with a substantial manning constraint, Civilian personnel not only overcame several daunting challenges, but excelled while doing it. The Non-Appropriated Fund section was tasked with implementation of the increase of minimum wage to \$15 an hour, processing 197 pay adjustments in just under two weeks. While the US Team suffered from a %50 staff reduction, they were able to recieve firm offers, which will result in 26 employees on-boarding in April. Additionally, the Forgein National Team was lauded by Tri-Service for their last-minute ability to step in to provide interpretation services at critical conditions of employment negotiations.
